# Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul (MRO)

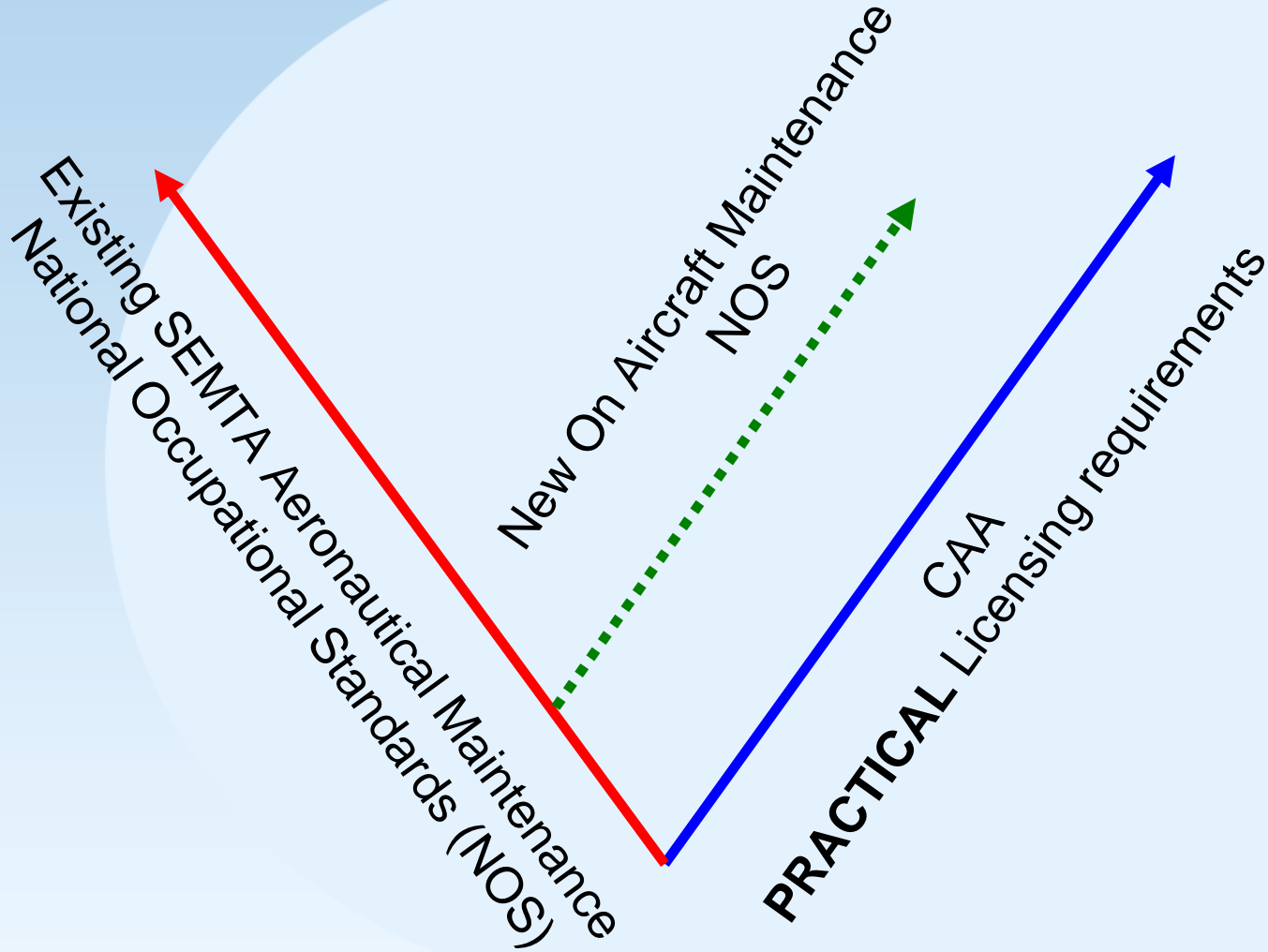

- UK's aircraft and aerospace industry is the largest in the world outside the USA.
- Significant driver of regional and national economic growth and productivity.
- Our employers currently invest £2 billion in training each year.
- New opportunities in the Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul market.
- Annual turnover of £9.1 billion in 2014 for the UK.
- Numbers of Licenced engineers dwindle from 24,000 in 1979 to 12,000 today.
- Yet during the same period, aircraft numbers have more than doubled!
- Need to act now!
