AIRSPACE CHANGE PROPOSAL - NOTIFICATION OF THE RECEIPT OF AN AIRSPACE CHANGE PROPOSAL FOR THE RECLASSIFICATION OF THE GLASGOW CONTROL AREA (CTA) FROM CLASS E TO CLASS D

This letter is to advise you that the Directorate has received the subject airspace change proposal from NATS Ltd/ATC Glasgow Airport. The proposal seeks the establishment of a known traffic environment within the subject airspace through the reclassification of the CTA from Class E to Class D.

This activity follows the Sponsor's completion of Stage 4 of the Airspace Change Process (Consultation and Formal Proposal Submission) as described in CAP 725 – CAA Guidance on the Application of the Airspace Change Process. The Sponsor's target implementation for the change is 17 December 2009 (AIRAC 13/2009).

In order to gain regulatory approval, the Proposal will need to satisfy the regulatory requirements as demonstrated through the quality of the operational and environmental analysis and the thoroughness of the consultation. The DAP Project Leader is Dave Drake of the Controlled Airspace Section.
